Selection

The Scholarship Selection Committee meets in the spring of each year to review scholarship applications. Awards will be made by the Trustees pursuant to adopted procedures and by final approval of the Foundation's Board of Trustees. Applicants who have already been awarded a scholarship in previous years have an ongoing duty to reapply each year. Furthermore, recipients who fail to reapply will not be considered for scholarship for the year. Finally, Trustees have the right to change the applicant's scholarship classification.

Each application <u>must</u> include a copy of the applicant's academic transcript. Although not required, applicants are encouraged to include a resume. Applications are due no later than <u>Monday April 17</u>, 2023 at 12:00pm (NO EXCEPTIONS).

Sales & Marketing Council Scholarship
